Coaches arrive at Radstock Site at 8.45am. EH and CVC connecting coaches leave the Radstock Site at 8.55am. Arrival at CVC 9.05am and EH at 9.25am.

Return journeys: EH leaves Keynsham at 3.40pm and CVC at 4.05pm. All coaches at Radstock Site leave at 4.20pm for their respective route home.

You are advised to arrive at your designated stop 5 minutes prior to your pick up time.

Route E arrives EH at 8.45am
Leaves EH at 3.40pm for return journey.

Norton Radstock College Transport Information 2009/2010

Congratulations - You are now a student at Norton Radstock College. The College provides fully subsidised transport to enable students to access their courses. You will be issued a bus pass which allows you to travel on the days when you are in timetabled classes, it is not to be used for shopping trips or socialising.

Although there is no charge to use the coaches all students who require transport will need to complete a 'Transport Requirement' form which includes the 'Code of Conduct'.

The College provides connecting coaches from main site to Ellsbridge House and CVC, which is also free of charge.

Your bus pass allows you to travel on days that you attend College. If you have to attend College on other days e.g. for an exam, contact Student Services (01761 438539) a few days before you need to travel as numbers are limited.

Always carry your bus pass as you will have to show it to the driver, as the driver has the right to refuse travel.

We expect you to be considerate and only take up one seat. The front two seats on each bus have been set aside for students with limited mobility, a learning difficulty, those bringing children to the College Nursery and the elderly. You can use these seats if no-one is using them but you must give the seat up immediately if an elderly student, a student with a child, limited mobility or learning difficulty boards the bus.

If buses are fitted with seatbelts you should wear them at all times. Smoking and the use of bad or offensive language is not permitted on College buses.

For your own and other passengers' safety, it is very important that you don't take part in boisterous behaviour, make too much noise or in any other way distract the driver. You should not throw any objects from the bus windows or shout at people passing by. CCTV cameras operate on most College buses. Standing is not allowed as this is against Health and Safety regulations. If you cause any damage to a College bus, you will no longer be allowed to use College buses and you will have to pay all costs to repair the damage.

If you misbehave on the bus, the driver will provide details to Student Services who will investigate the incident and take action as necessary.

Business cards printed with the coach company's telephone numbers will be issued to students using the transport. Please contact Centurion Travel direct should the coach fail to arrive at the stated time.

Take care of your bus pass. If you lose it you can get a replacement from Student Services but this will cost you £2.00. Should you no longer wish to travel on the coach, please inform Student Services and return your bus pass.

In the event of severe weather, contact the coach company before leaving home or listen to Radio Bristol or GWR local radio broadcasts.
